What are Home Groups?

Home Groups are a great way to meet others in an informal setting to discuss the Christian faith and particularly how it applies to everyday issues. They enable us to support each other and to develop really meaningful friendships.

Why join a Home Group?

Some Home Group members find meeting during the week very helpful in reinforcing the shared worship experience at Church on a Sunday. Others are simply more comfortable being part of a smaller informal group than going regularly to a Sunday Church service.

If you are new to the parish, or an established resident interested in finding out more about the Christian faith, joining a Home Group is an excellent place to start. Whatever the situation, Home Groups have an increasingly important part to play in our spiritual development and growth as a parish.

Who goes and what do they do?

Approximately 120 people in the parish already attend a Home Group. Each group has around 6-14 members.

Although each Group determines its own "feel", a meeting will typically involve considering what the Bible has to say about the way we live our lives and how we should approach personal challenges and opportunities. There is a suggested topic for each meeting which ties into the teaching at the churches around the same time. The format and tenor of these discussions is shaped by the Group themselves - Home Group members range from "seasoned" churchgoers to those still in the early stages of exploring the Christian faith.

When do they happen?

Home Groups generally meet once a fortnight. Four groups currently meet during the day, while the remainder meet in the evening. All gather at the home of one of the members. A meeting will generally last a couple of hours, but there are no rules!

Hmm, sounds interesting - how do I find out more?

A list of current Home Group leaders is shown overleaf. If you know one of these people in particular, why not just give them a call? You can also contact Diane Davidson, who co-ordinates the Home Groups, or simply catch up with a couple of people who you know are members of Home Groups to get a further insight.

Absolutely! our Youth Ministry has groups running during the week just for you - just speak to them or give them a ring to find out what's on.
